

Oral anti-cancer treatments

Information for patients

All prescriptions for oral anti-cancer treatments are checked by a trained Cancer Pharmacist. We are here to ensure that your treatment is safe for you, that it is not affected by any medications you already take, and to answer any questions you may have regarding your medication.

When starting on a new oral anti-cancer therapy there are some extra checks that we need to complete which can take a little longer than normal.

As it is your first time on this treatment, the Pharmacist will talk to you or your nominated carer about the medication you are being given.

For this reason, your first prescription needs to be collected from:

Boots Pharmacy Bexley Wing between 9am & 5pm Mon - Fri
(This is different to the opening hours of Boots)
