## What happens now?

- Your chest X-ray will be checked by a specialist.
- Occasionally the specialist who looks at your chest X-ray may arrange for another test. You would be contacted directly by the hospital to arrange this.
- If we try to contact you, the hospital number will display on your telephone as 0113 206 9999 or 0113 733 4974.
- The X-ray report should be with your GP in 1-2 weeks.
- It is essential that you contact your GP to find out the results of your chest X-ray.

If you have persistent or worsening symptoms please contact your GP or NHS 111.
