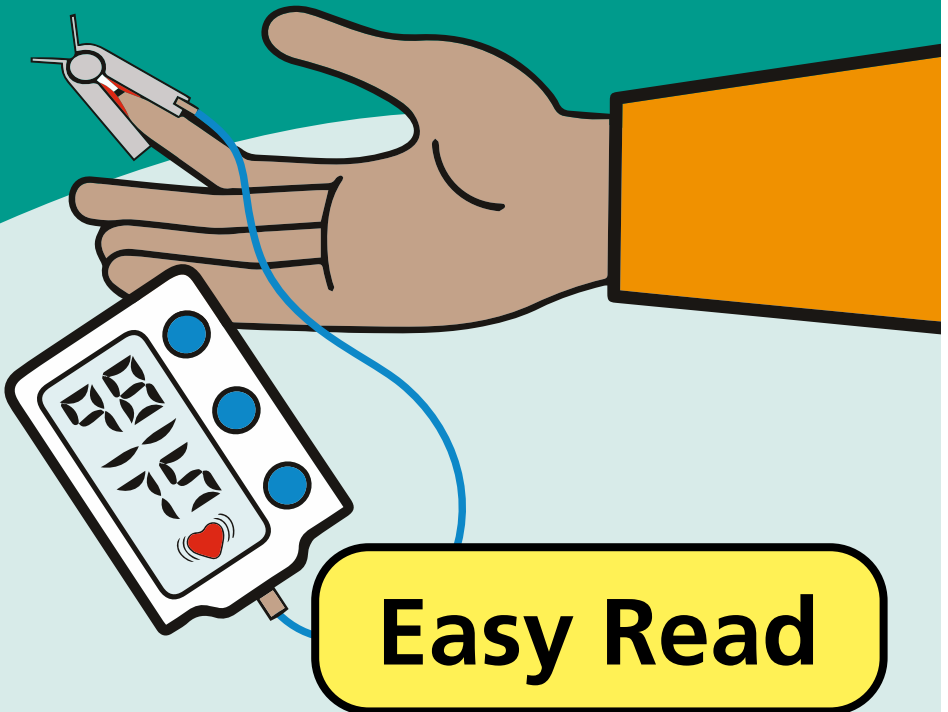


Having your oxygen level checked

healthy heart

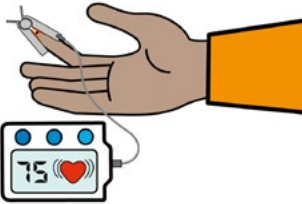


Your oxygen levels tell us if your body is getting what it needs.

medical notes



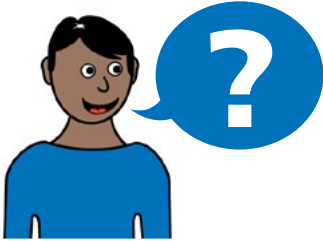
It will take between one or two minutes and it doesn't hurt.
