Some hospital appointments don't need to be face to face.



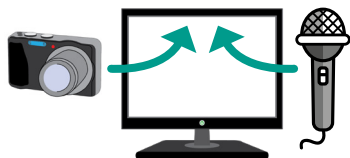
You could have your appointment using a computer, tablet or your phone.

You need to have an internet connection to do this.

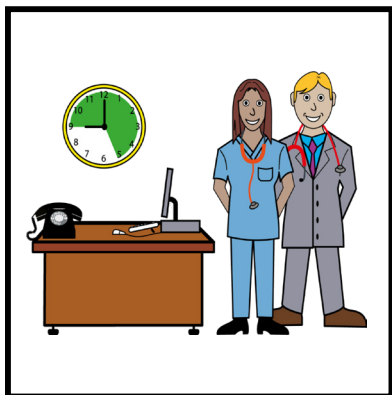
## camera / microphone



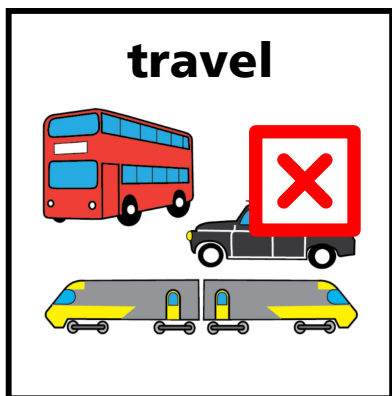
Your computer, tablet or phone needs to have a camera and a microphone on it.



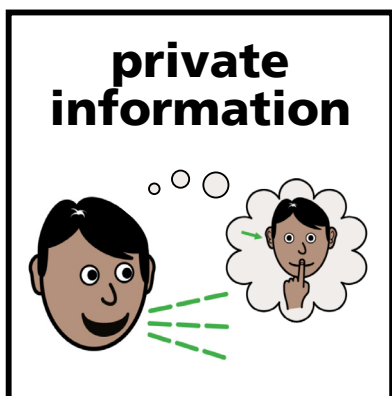
You need to have Google Chrome on your device. Or Safari if you use an Apple Device.



Instead of a waiting area you wait at home with your device.

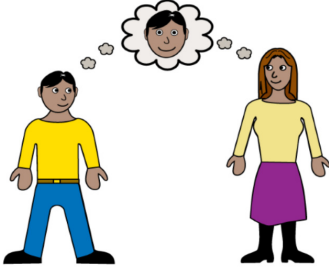


You won't need to travel to hospital.
