You might want to ask someone to help you read it.





Medical staff might want you to have a catheter.



Catheters mean you wee into a bag.

You do not need to go to the toilet to wee.







A tube will go into your bladder.

Your wee will come down the tube and into a bag.


You will not feel this.




If you have male genital organs the tube will go up your penis into your bladder.




If you have female genital organs the tube will go into your bladder through your urethra.



It is held in place with a small balloon.



It may feel uncomfortable when it is put in.



Once in it should be comfortable. You will not know that you are weeing.



You will be able to see the tube and bag for your wee.



Don't pull the tubes, it will hurt if you pull them.



Your nurse will help you look after the catheter while you are poorly.



You can talk to your nurse about the catheter.
