## Covid-19

When you come into the hospital, it may feel a little strange as lots of people will be wearing special protective clothing (PPE) such as special pyjamas ("scrubs"), masks, aprons and gloves. Wearing these things can help to stop the spread of Coronavirus. Staff and adults will be wearing a mask in the hospital...whilst you do not have to, you are welcome to wear one or a face covering if that feels **comfortable** for you.

## Your appointment

During your appointment, you will do some activities with a member of the Psychology team who will be wearing a mask. This is to keep you and everyone **safe**.

You may not be able to see the expressions of your Psychologist, such as when they are smiling, but they are still able to listen and to help you.
