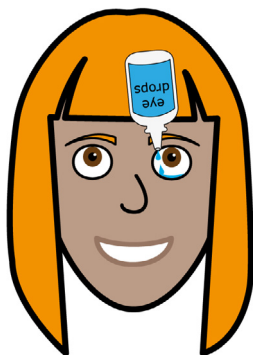
## easy read

They are drops used to treat eye problems caused by swelling.

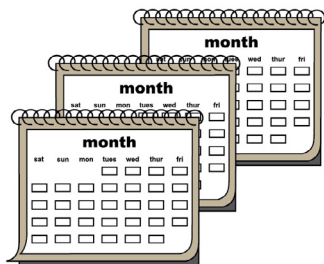
## **prescribed medication**
