









You might want to ask someone to help you read it.

Foreskin is the loose skin at the top of your penis.


Some people have this done because of their cultural or spiritual beliefs.

Some people have this done because the skin is too tight.

This can cause problems like pain or infections.

having an anaesthetic







You will be given medicines in hospital so this operation does not hurt.

Other Easy Read about having an anaesthetic are available.

They will make a small cut to remove the loose skin.

After the operation you will go to the recovery area.



When you are ready the nurse will get you something to eat and drink.





You will need to have a wee.

When you feel better you can usually go home.



Our staff will tell you how to look after your penis until it is completely better.



They will arrange any follow up appointments you might need.
