do not worry

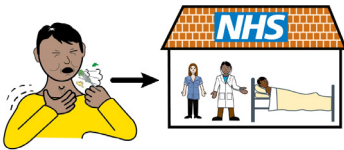


This can sound quite scary but please do not worry.

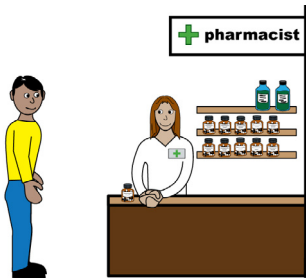
outside the hospital

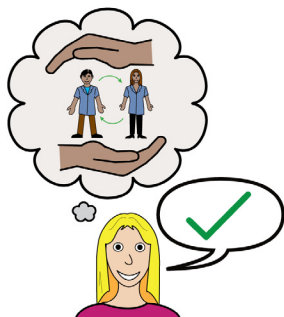
