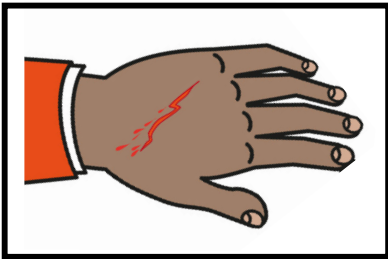
Sepsis can make you very poorly.

Tell a nurse or a doctor if you have any of these symptoms:

- Painful or red cannula site.



- Coughing up green sputum.



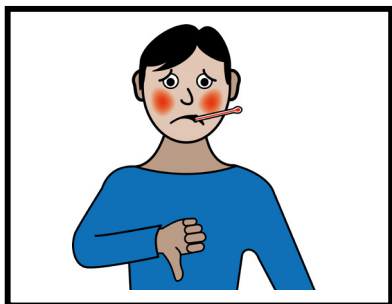
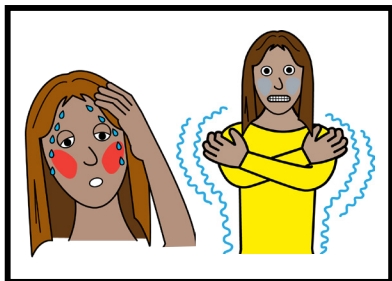
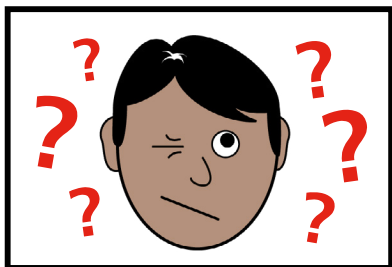
- Painful, leaking or red wound.



- Skin rash or clammy, sweaty skin.



- Not passing much (or any) urine or painful when passing.



- Feeling confused, disorientated or slurring speech.
- Feeling very hot or cold, chills or shivering.
- Feeling very unwell, extreme pain or “the worst ever”.
