



This booklet uses easy words and pictures.

You might want to ask someone to help you read it.



You will come to the hospital eye clinic to have your eyes checked.



You might meet an Orthoptist, Optometrist or a Doctor.

We all do different jobs to check if your eyes are healthy and help you see better.



You will go to a room with an orthoptist.



The orthoptist will check what you can see by asking you to look at pictures or letters. You can say, sign or point to say what you see, or the orthoptist can watch where you look.



The orthoptist might put drops in your eyes.


The drops might feel uncomfortable at first.



You will wait until the drops work.




You will wait in the waiting room



Things might look more blurred.




The eye drops help the optometrist measure your eyes to see if you need glasses.



The optometrist or doctor will shine a light in your eyes. This is to check that your eyes are healthy inside.

This is ok.




You might need to put your chin and forehead on the metal bar.




You may have pictures taken of your eyes.

This is in a different part of the hospital called Gledhow Wing Eye Clinic.



You will need to put your chin and forehead on the metal bar in front of a special camera.



Stay still and look at the light.



This is quick.



This will not hurt.



You then go back to the Eye Clinic and talk to the doctor.

The doctor will discuss your plan with you.



You can then usually go home.
