




This booklet uses easy words and pictures.

An EEG


(electroencephalogram) is used to see what electrical activity is happening in your brain.



An EEG isn't painful.



Someone can stay with you in the room.




The staff will touch your head and stick on some stickers.

They will connect cables to the stickers.



These might be cold.


Some people think the glue is smelly.



These connect to a computer that records the information.




You can bring some activities to do.



You will need keep the stickers and cables on for 20 minutes.



You will need to stay still.



When the EEG is finished the cables and stickers will be removed.


Your hair might be sticky.




You will be able to go home after.



You will need to wash your hair when you get home.



The doctor will review the results and let you know what will happen next.
