




This booklet uses easy words and pictures.

Aspiration pneumonia is an infection in your lungs.




It happens when something gets into your lungs that shouldn't. Like food or drinks. Or your own saliva.




Aspiration pneumonia can make you very sick.



You might need to come to hospital.




You might need antibiotics and oxygen therapy.




Some people will die from aspiration pneumonia.



You are more at risk of getting aspiration pneumonia if your swallow is not good.




Or You cannot sit yourself up independently.



You are more at risk of getting aspiration pneumonia if you have had it before.



We can help you reduce your risk of getting aspiration pneumonia by:



Making sure you get the right assessments and care for your swallow and chest if needed.



Always sit upright when eating and drinking.




Always follow the advice given about eating and drinking.



Make sure you keep you mouth clean by brushing your teeth regularly using a fluoride toothpaste.



Poor hygiene in your mouth means some bugs (bacteria) could get to your lungs causing the infection.



Have dental check ups every 12 months.
