



We will invite you for a check to make sure your breasts are healthy between the ages of 50-70.

It is your choice if you want to have your breasts checked.



Having your breasts checked is important but if you are worried or unsure please call us on **0113 733 4974 - Option 6**

Please do not use talcum powder or a spray underarm deodorant before your appointment.

But you can use a roll-on deodorant.

It is a good idea to wear a top with a skirt or trousers, so you only have to take your top off for the test.



You can bring a family member, friend, or carer with you.
