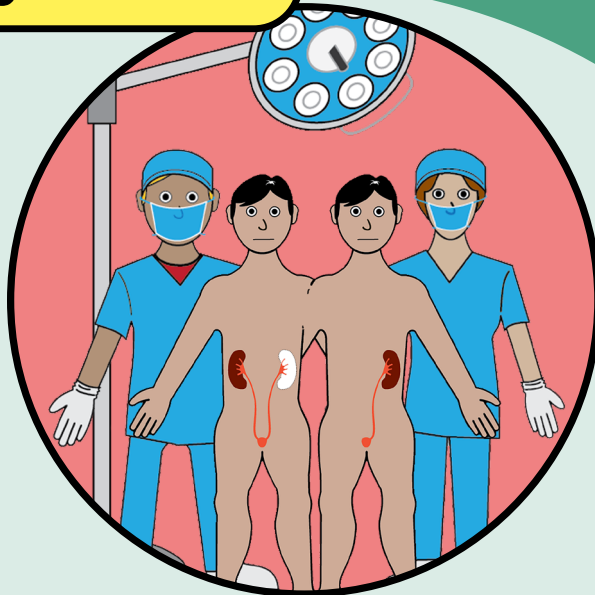

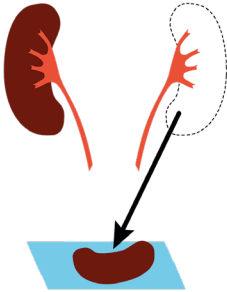

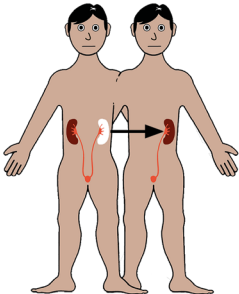
You might want to ask someone to help you read it.

stop smoking



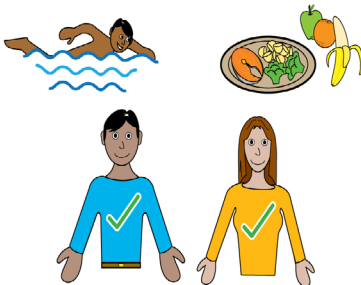
Stop smoking.

healthy teeth

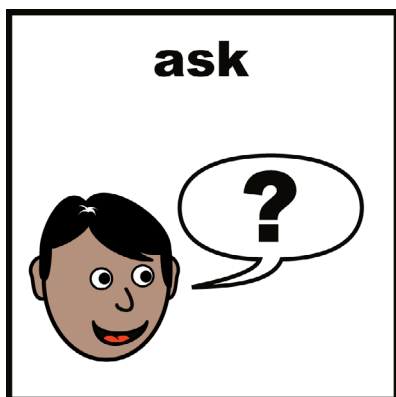


Have good dental health.
