




The doctors think you are suitable for a kidney transplant.





Live donor, this can be a family or friend who offers to give you a kidney.




If you have a family or friend who would like to offer let your transplant coordinator know.



They will explain how they can get tested to see if there kidney will work for you.




The other transplant option is a deceased Donor.



You would be placed on the national transplant register,




This is a waiting list of everyone needing a new kidney in the uk.

Their kidney will be offered to someone on the national transplant register who is the best match.




Sometimes it can take a long time to find a match.
