

This appointment is to check your breasts are healthy.




There is a useful leaflet which looks like this which provides lots of information.

Having your breasts checked is important but if you are worried or unsure please call us on **0113 733 4974 - Option 6**




Please do not use talcum powder or a spray underarm deodorant before your appointment.
