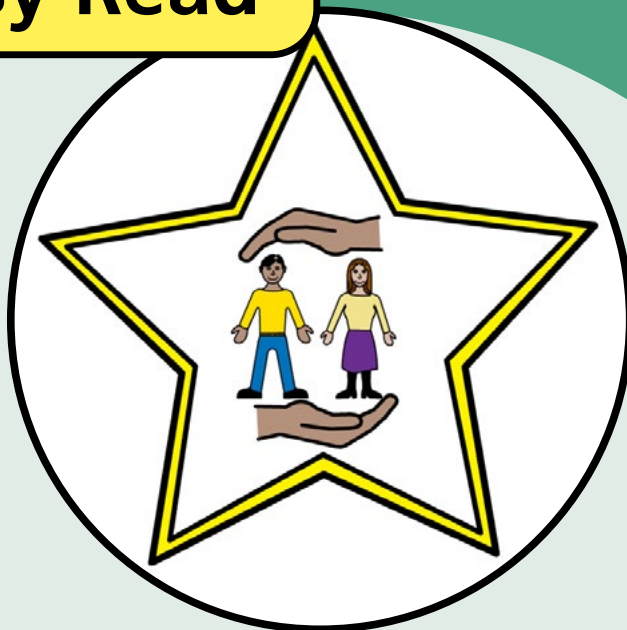

(ETOC).



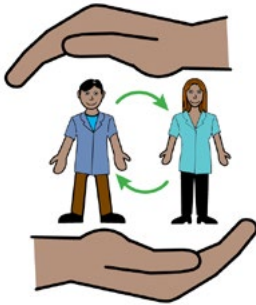
The aim promote safe
