

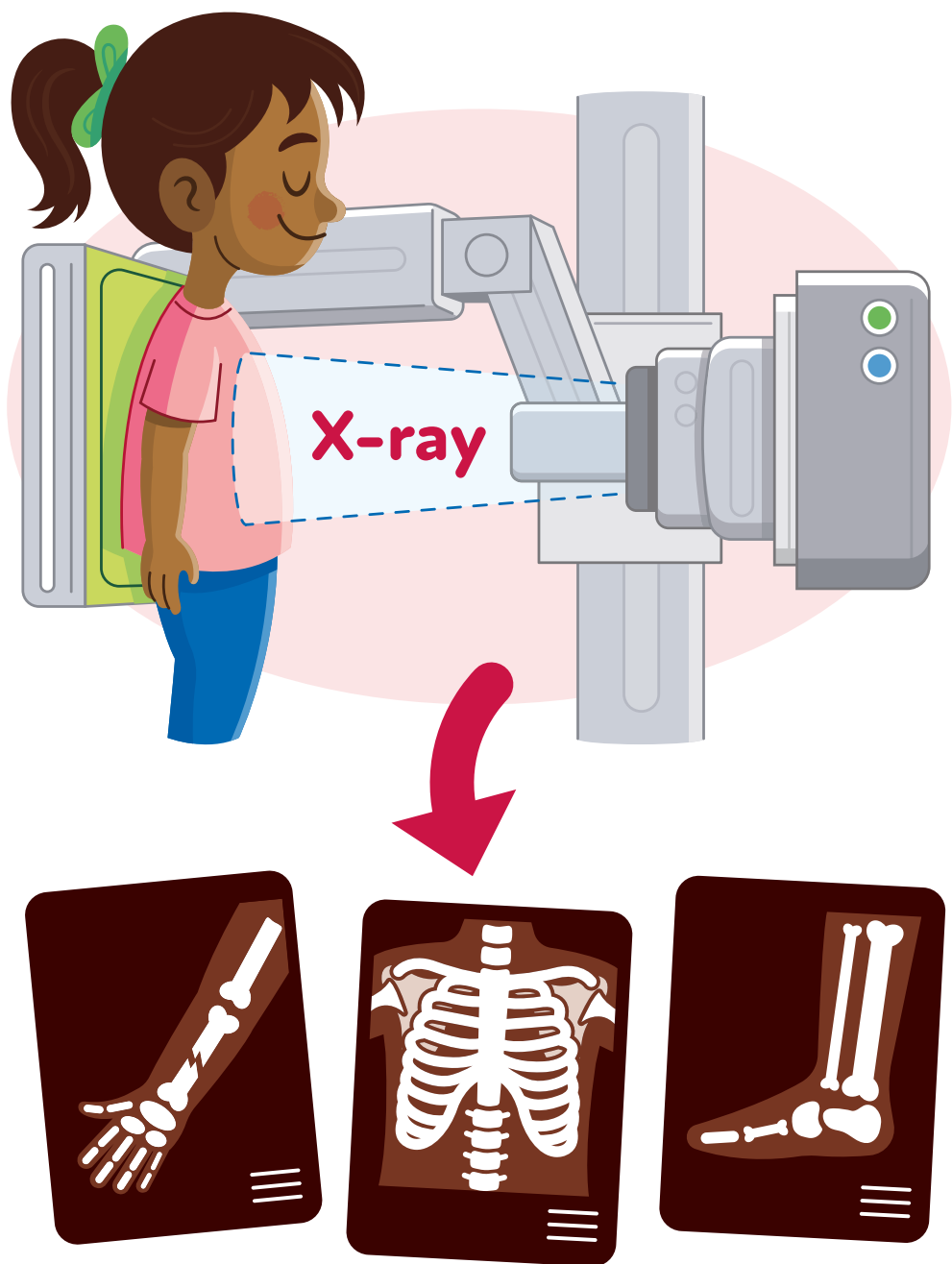

They will need to wear a special apron.
